



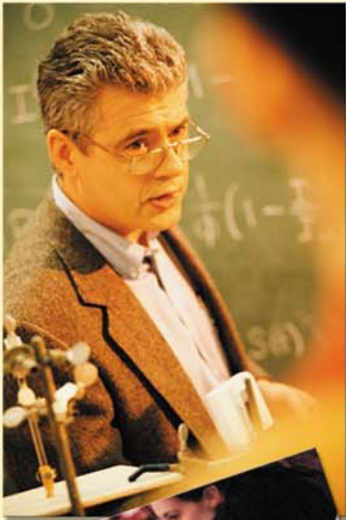

Career Pathways Leadership Certification Workshops

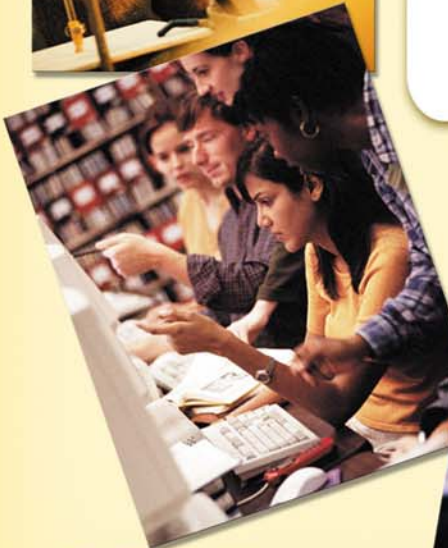
